For my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations: a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel.”

Isaiah 11:1-2

A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit.

The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him—the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord—and he will delight in the fear of the Lord.

Isaiah 35: 5-6

THE LAST DAYS (1)

Luke 19: 38

“Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord!” “Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!”

Psalm 118: 26 Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
From the house of the Lord we bless you.

Luke 22 47-48 ...one of the Twelve, was leading them. He approached Jesus to kiss him, but Jesus asked him, “Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?”

Psalm 41:9 Even my close friend, someone I trusted, one who shared my bread,
has turned against me

Luke 23:9 Herodplied him with many questions, but Jesus gave him no answer.

Isaiah 53:7 He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth.

THE LAST DAYS (2)

Luke 23:35 The people stood watching, and the rulers even sneered at him. They said, “He saved others; let him save himself if he is God’s Messiah, the Chosen One.”

Psalm 22 17-18 All my bones are on display; people stare and gloat over me. They divide my clothes among them and cast lots for my garment

Luke 23: 36-37 The soldiers also came up and mocked him. They offered him wine vinegar and said, “If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself.

Psalm 69:21 They put gall in my food and gave me vinegar for my thirst

Luke 24:51
While he was blessing them, he left them and was taken up into heaven

Psalm 68: 17-18 the Lord has come from Sinai into his sanctuary. When you ascended on high, you took many captives; you received gifts from people, even from the rebellious—that you, Lord God, might dwell there.
